### Section D: Design the Participative Process

#### 10. Possible answers to the guiding questions to achieve your mission:

*1. In your view, what should the participatory initiative of ANDRA be intended for?*

It depends on the participants' strategy in advising ANDRA. One: to be closer to the local population.

*2. Which issues might be open to consultation (or should not) with local population? Should the local population take part in the process of zone restriction? How? According to which criteria could this zone be defined?*

It depends, but some topic to discuss: should they be able to participate in the design of the storage centre? Which balance between technical and social criteria? Social criteria: economic, cultural... short term/long term (sustainable development, for instance). Public participation in safety issues?

*3. Which topics are more likely to be appropriated by the local population? How would you deal with the topic of technical complexity in your proposal? How would you address the issue of nuclear identity?*

Probably health impact and environment. Focus with open questions on local impacts. Small working groups, good information. Nuclear identity? Depends on dynamics.

*4. What could be the general form of the dossier addressed to the CNDP?*

Two extremes: informative, aimed at the national level or an account of the public participation initiatives at the local level.
